About THPP

THPP is a transitional housing placement opportunity for current foster and probation youth ages 16 to 18. The goal of the program is to arm youth with the necessary life skills to live independently upon exiting the child welfare system.

The THPP model allows youth to live with a roommate in a safe and secure single-family dwelling in San Jose. In addition, youth receive regular support and supervision from our THPP staff, county social workers, and connects youth to ILP programs in Santa Clara County. Youth are staffed with a full-time on-site case manager/administrator, an in house social worker/therapist providing individual and/or group sessions as well as 24/7 presence of residential counselors.

Services Offered Include:

- Educational Guidance
- Employment Counseling
- Assistance in reaching emancipation goals outlined in youth's Transitional Independent Living Plan (TILP)
- Case Plan Emancipation Readiness
